Job Summary

The successful candidate must be a skilled Carpenter with knowledge of various carpentry techniques. The Scalish Construction Carpenter will work closely with Site Superintendents, Subcontractors and vendors. They will be responsible for layout, installation, repairing, finishing, and maintaining various structures, fixtures, and buildings. Other duties will include designing, cutting, and measuring materials according to a client's requirements.

A successful applicant should be hardworking, reliable, possess a team mindset, have great hand eye coordination, be a good communicator and highly organized.

Essential Functions

- Ability to read and interpret blueprints and designs to work to specifications prepared by other construction professionals, architects and building code recommendations.
- Assist supervisors with structural design, planning, layout, and installation.
- Conduct repair work and installation of doors, windows, drywall, cabinets, stairs, and other fixtures as required.
- Ability to assess the quality of woodwork and materials.
- Ability to operate tools, machines, and other equipment.
- Remain compliant with local building codes, and health and safety regulations.
- Provide excellent customer service.
- Ability to stand for prolonged periods, climb, pull, and lift heavy objects.
- Install wooden structures such as roofing frames, rafters, partitions, joists and stud work.
- Design and install cabinets, shelving, fitted furniture, drywall and insulation.
- Select lumber by size and strength to suit each job, sourcing wood to suit the customer's budget and style.

- Liaise with clients, suppliers, and other construction professionals.
- Review on site daily progress and make sure next steps are in order.
- Provide updates to Site Superintendents and address any issues for each construction worksite.
- Manage and maintain accuracy of material take-off sheets.
- Accomplish construction project results by defining project purposes, predicting required resources, and coordinate with vendors.
- Material Procurement as needed for each project.
- Provide job site documentation and photos before, during and after project completion.
- OSHA Compliant
- All other duties as assigned.
